Rules and Regulations



Welcome to Horizons Village! Please read this guide to neighborhood rules to help make your stay pleasant and enjoyable.

Noise



- Sound travels far in the woods! Be mindful of other residents (humans and wildlife).
- No disruptive parties or loud noises.
- No amplified outdoor music.

Lights



- “Dark sky” is standard in Horizons Village. Turn off exterior lights at night.

Firepits and Grills



- If the house has a firepit and/or outdoor grill, use responsibly and cautiously, as we are surrounded by woods.
- Use the spark screen and fully extinguish the fire before turning in.

Pets



- Pets are welcome if your host allows.
- Do not let pets roam off leash—there are bobcats, coyotes, wolves, and mountain lions in the region.

Use of Chemicals



- All homes in Horizons Village use private wells and septic systems. Use of toxic chemicals such as pesticides and insecticides is strictly prohibited.

Bear Safety



- Black bears are common in Horizons Village. Dispose of trash in a secure location and remove food, beverages, and other attractants from porches, patios, and decks.
- If a bear comes around the house, scare it away by yelling from a safe distance.
- Keep car doors locked and do not leave food in cars.

Cars and Roads



- Drive slowly to minimize dust and protect the gravel roads. Obey the 20 mph speed limit at all times.
- Be mindful of wildlife and pedestrians.
- No parking on circles or shoulders.

Hunting and Fishing



- No hunting, fishing, or harming wildlife.

Firearms



- No discharging firearms, including air and pellet guns.

Common Area



- Guests may use the riverfront common area with the host’s permission.
- No motorized vehicles or campfires.
